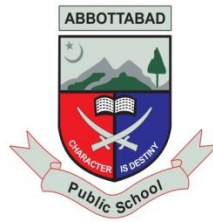

MESS MANNERS AND ETIQUETTES

Abbottabad Public School's Administration has designed proper ‘**Table Manners Guide**’ for students. The designed panaflex includes guidelines for use of napkin, toothpick, etiquette, table settings, and utensil's use. It emphasizes good hygiene practices, discreet use of toothpicks, and proper placement of utensils. The panaflex has been placed on the walls of all three mess halls for easy reference of students. This ensures that all students have access to the guidelines and can follow proper table manners during meals.

USE OF NAPKINS

- Should only be used to wipe the lips and finger tips.
- Should be spread over the lap so that drippings do not spoil your clothes.
- Do not place the napkin around your neck or against your chest.
- After use, do not fold the napkin; lay it casually on the right side. Napkin placed casually indicates "napkin used."
- If paper napkin has been used, place it crumpled in your plate after use.



USE OF TOOTHPICK

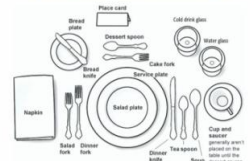
- Toothpick should always be used sparingly. If you must use it, do so only to clean your teeth and not to play with it.

- If you dig something out, do not blow it or spit it out. Either swallow or collect it, and place it on your plate.
- After using the toothpick, place it in the plate. Do not break it into pieces.

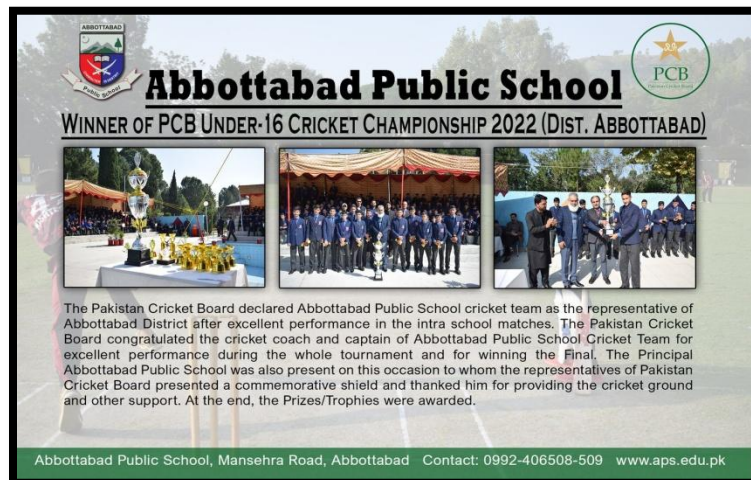


LEADERSHIP AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT

AOBA (REUNION – 2022)

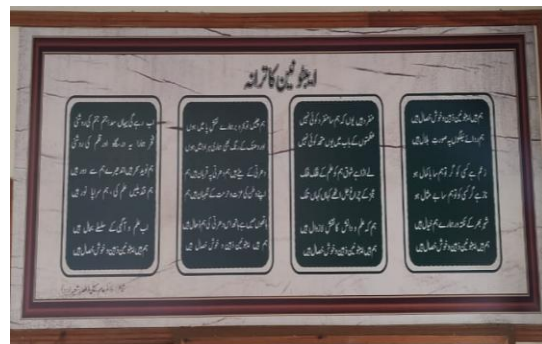

REVIVAL OF GLORY

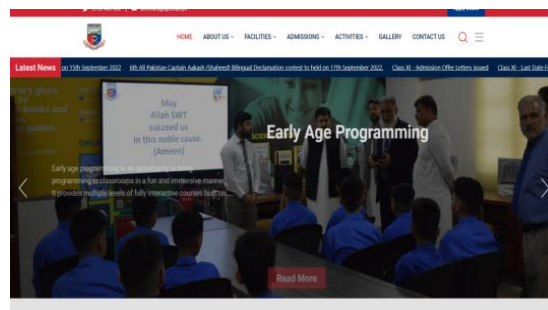
APS ANTHEM BY Dr. AAMIR SOHAIL


WEBSITE DEVELOPMENT

ONLINE ADMISSIONS

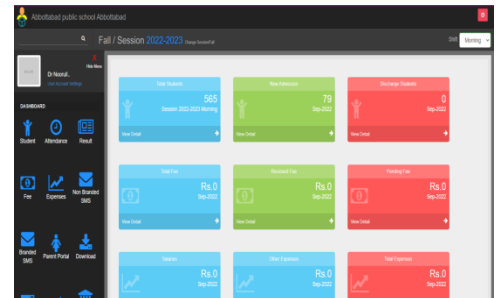

CCTV CAMERAS

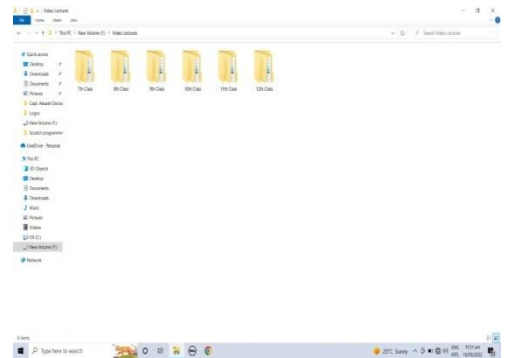

To ensure effective monitoring of the cameras, the school has set up a dedicated control room equipped with advanced surveillance technology and staffed by trained CCTV operator.



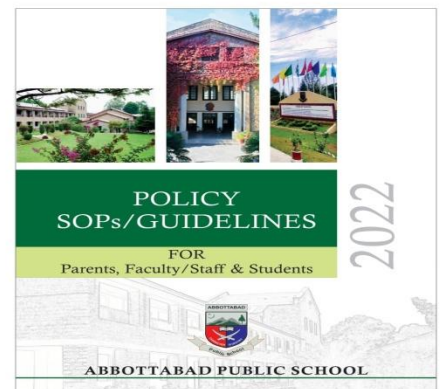
VIDEO LECTURES FOR ALL CLASSES
